Order 1: Came on for discussion was whether to engage Joe Heflin and Associates for the wind energy issue.

Heflin notified the court that he may not be available to represent the county, but recommends that the county seek outside representation since the legal issue is so specialized.

The meeting recessed at 2:00 P.M.


The meeting resumed at 2:02 P.M.


Joe Heflin suggested conferring with Attorney Munk when considering outside representation for the county.

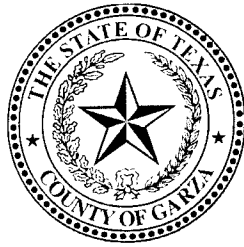
