

A special meeting of the Commissioners Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Thursday, January 1, 2009 at 9:00 A.M., at the courtroom, at the Garza County Courthouse, 3005 W. Main, Post with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners: Pct. 1-Gary McDaniel; Pct. 2-Charles Morris; and Pct. 4-Mike Sanchez. Outgoing Pct. 3 Commissioner John Valdez was not present.

County officials present were: Jim Plummer, Clerk; Judy Bush, Tax Assessor-Collector; Cliff Laws, Sheriff; Eric Cravy, Constable-1; Daniel Yarbrow, Constable-2; Also present were newly elected county officials: Mike Munk, Attorney and Ted A. Brannon, Pct. 3 Commissioner.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M.

Order 1: County Judge Norman administered the Oath of Office to elected officials from the November 4, 2008 General Election. They included: Attorney Mike Munk, Sheriff Cliff Laws, Tax Assessor/Collector Judy M. Bush, Pct. 1 Commissioner Gary L. McDaniel, Pct. 3 Commissioner Ted A. Brannon, Constable-1 Eric D. Cravy and Constable-2 Daniel A. Yarbrow. (Oaths of Office, Statements of Elected/Appointed Officer and Official Bonds are recorded in the county clerk's Official Bond records.)

Order 2: Came on before the court was the opportunity to inspect the new Garza County Law Enforcement Center. The court members, other elected officials and visitors toured the facility. Judge Norman lead the commissioners on a thorough visual inspection and compiled a list of items that need attention for the soon to open facility.
