A special meeting of the Commissioners Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Thursday, February 19, 2009 at 9:00 A.M., at the Garza County Law Enforcement Center, at 412 E 15th St. Post, TX 79356 with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners: Pct. 1-Gary McDaniel; Pct. 3-Ted Brannon; and Pct. 4-Mike Sanchez.
